Dove shot placement

When the birds come into view, they will likely arrive in groups containing 20 to 50 doves. Pick a single bird at a time as a target. When the dove is flying across your view horizontally, take a 6 foot lead. Typically, one inch of barrel movement is equal to one foot of lead for the bird.

The History of Dove Hunting in Argentina

In Argentina, there are tens of millions of doves or "Palomas". The hunting of doves in Argentina has a long history that began over 30 years ago. Hunting in Argentina began with doves and has since evolved to include larger game hunting, such as Red deer, blackbuck, water buffalo axis deer and many other interesting big game.



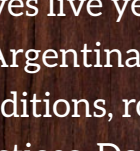
Doves usually make their nests out of sticks, and their eggs are incubated by both the male and the female parent.



Doves feed on seeds, fruit, and plants. Unlike most other birds, they produce a type of milk.



Doves flight patterns change based on which grain fields offer prime feeding opportunities.



A dove hunter in Argentina will often fire off an average of **1000 rounds** in a single day.

Where to Hunt the Dove in Argentina

Doves live year round in the warmer areas of Argentina due to the ideal climate, soil conditions, roosting areas and farming practices. Doves tend to roost in areas that larger predators, such as eagles, hawks, and other large mammals, cannot get to.



Best Guns and Caliber to Hunt Dove

Many dove hunters prefer autoloaders since doves are fast and autoloaders can send three quick shots before the bird flies out of range. A longer barrel length is good for faster moving targets 28 and 20 gauge guns are all good choices.

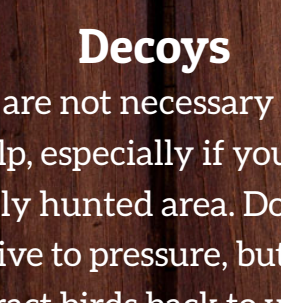

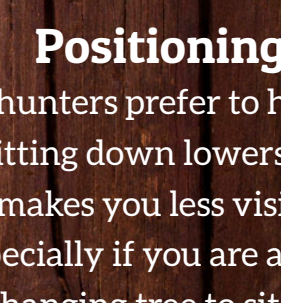

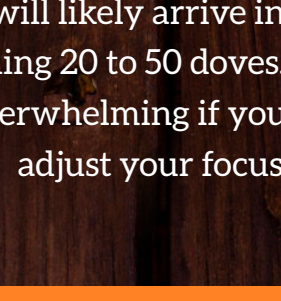
Decoys

Decoys are not necessary but a few can help, especially if you are in a heavily populated area. Doves are sensitive to pressure, but decoys can attract birds back to your field.



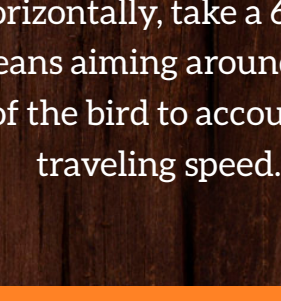
Positioning

Many hunters prefer to hunt dove sitting. Sitting down lowers your body which makes you less visible to the birds, especially if you are able to find a low hanging tree to sit under.



Focus on a target

When the birds come into view, they will likely arrive in groups containing 20 to 50 doves. This can be overwhelming if you do not adjust your focus.



Aim

When the dove is flying across your view horizontally, take a 6 foot lead. This means aiming around 6 feet in front of the bird to account for its traveling speed.

Córdoba

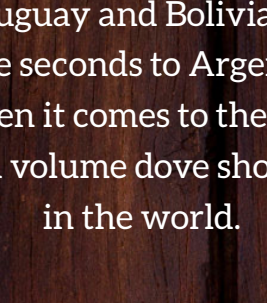

The top destination in Argentina to hunt doves is Entre Rios, a province located in Argentina's northeastern Mesopotamia region.

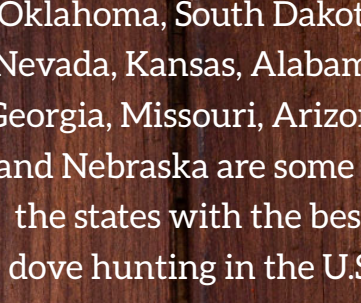

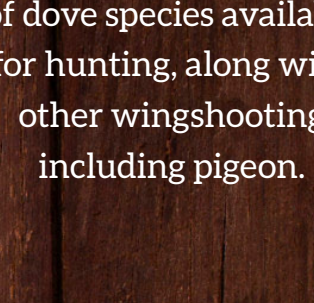
Uruguay and Bolivia

How to Prepare Dove After a Hunt

Although small, weighing only an average of 4.5 ounces each, doves are commonly hunted for their meat. To feed one person, it usually takes about 2-3 doves. One dove makes for a good appetizer. Pigeons are a little larger, so one pigeon may be enough for a main course for one person.

Cleaning Process

When preparing dove meat there are two main ways to do it: plucking or breasting. Plucking will result in the whole dove being ready to cook, while breasting prepares just the breast meat.

Cooking Process

Doves do not take very long to cook since they are so small. The meat can be grilled, roasted, fried, smoked, and stewed in many different ways. People say dove is best when grilled because it makes the skin crispy while not overcooking the breast meat. Dove should be served medium, still a little pink inside. Roasting is the second most common way to cook dove meat.
