

Hunting in Argentina began with doves and has since evolved to include larger game hunting, such as Red deer, blackbuck, water buffalo axis deer and many other interesting big game.

The History of Dove **Hunting in Argentina**

Doves usually make their nests out of sticks, and their eggs are incubated by both the male and the female parent. Doves feed on seeds, fruit, and plants. Unlike most other birds, they produce a type of milk.
